

9th ENES HPC Workshop on High Performance Computing for Weather and Climate

**SMHI, Norrköping, Sweden
19th - 21st May 2026**



Practical information

Norrköping is a city in the province of Östergötland in eastern Sweden, about 160 km south west of Stockholm, and 500 km north east of Denmark's capital Copenhagen.

How to get to Norrköping:

If coming all the way to Norrköping by train is not possible, you can fly to Stockholm, Linköping or even Copenhagen, and then take the train to Norrköping.

The average journey time by train between Stockholm Arlanda airport and Norrköping Central is 2 hours, with around 48 trains per day. You can also catch a train from Copenhagen, which takes 4-5 hours. From Linköping airport to Norrköping, you'll either need to catch a bus to Linköping Central Station and then a train to Norrköping central station, or a taxi will take around 30 minutes.

Distance to SMHI: 3.2 km, 45 min walk, 23 min by tram nr. 3 (Rådhuset to Sandtorp, direction Klockaretorpet, 8 stops)

Distance to SMHI: 2.7 km, 40 min walk, 17 min by tram nr. 3 (Söder Tull to Sandtorp, direction Klockaretorpet, 6 stops)
